OMAN'S PATHWAY TO PROGRESS

THE RUSAYL-BIDBID ROAD EXPANSION PROJECT

Oman's transportation sector is on a positive trajectory, evidenced by a 2.7% growth in GDP from transportation and storage between Q3, 2022, and Q3, 2023[1]. With vehicle registrations climbing to 1,660,803 by November 2023, and the expansion of the asphalted road network to 40,445 km by 2021, the need for an expanding infrastructure is clear. In response, the Rusayl-Bidbid Road Expansion Project emerges, led by the Ministry of Transport, Communications, and Information Technology (MTCIT).

The Rusayl-Bidbid Road Expansion, covering 27 km, enhances Muscat Expressway connectivity by linking Rusayl-Nizwa with Sharqiya Expressway interchanges. The initiative introduces additional lanes, service roads, and pedestrian paths to boost urban integration. Key upgrades include expanding Wadi Al-Jifnain and Wadi Fanja bridges, creating new intersections, and constructing a bridge in Al-Amqat. To ensure safety and longevity, the project incorporates box culverts for water management, lighting poles, barriers, and signage, all adhering to the highest traffic safety standards.

The Rusayl-Bidbid Road Expansion Project is expected to significantly impact Oman's economic landscape, boosting commercial, tourism, and economic activities. By improving connectivity across the sultanate, this project highlights the importance of roads in the nation's development and prosperity.


HOW IS IT USED?

► FORMATION OF LABOR MARKET REGULATORY COMMITTEE IN LOGISTICS SECTOR.

Ministry of Transport, Communications and Information Technology (MTCIT) formed a technical coordination committee specialized in researching and supporting provision of job opportunities in the logistics sector headed by the Undersecretary of MTCIT for Transport with membership from different government and private sector bodies. The Labor Market Regulatory Committee aims to organize the logistics labor market, providing job opportunities for Omani jobseekers first, obtaining appropriate national staff, implementation of Omanization and training replacement plans, collecting, studying and analyzing data about the logistics labor market.

▶ DEVELOPMENT, MANAGEMENT AND OPERATION OF NATIONAL PORT COMMUNITY SYSTEM

The National Logistics Community Project is an electronic platform or a single window that integrates various systems operated by stakeholders (sender, consignee, customs broker, shipping agent, etc.) who constitute the shipping and logistics community in Oman, including maritime, land, and air ports, as well as logistics services. The platform facilitates electronic exchange provided by joint entities in the supply chain, whether from commercial enterprises to other commercial enterprises, from commercial enterprises to the government, or from the government to governmental entities. The project aims to:

- Organize logistics operations from the beginning of the supply chain to the end, with the customer receiving the goods.
- Integrate stakeholders and operations under one window
- Facilitate and simplify the exchange of data and information among relevant parties.
- Improve efficiency, transparency, and coordination among different parties.
- Provide a central system for sharing information, tracking goods and documents, and managing logistics service operations.
- Enhance security and safety by improving cargo monitoring and tracking.
- Reduce paperwork and administrative procedures by transitioning to a digital system.

THE WAREHOUSING STANDARDS

This guide aims to integrate all the warehouse standards into a single book, which eases and spreads awareness to the investors in the logistics sector. The guide is going to be published to all entities related and involved to warehousing.

OMAN NATIONAL EWAYBILL

The Ministry of Transport, Communications, and Information Technology has launched the pilot project for the electronic transport document using blockchain technology at Sohar Port. The project aims to:

- Track the journey of goods within remote supply chains using smartphones around the clock.
- Ensure timely delivery and receipt of goods within the specified timeframe, with tight monitoring of the process.
- Provide accuracy, security, and complete reliability at all stages of the logistics process.
- Reduce manual operations and rely on automated logistics management.
- Safeguard the rights of all parties involved in the logistics process in a fair and equal manner.
- Establish an electronic storage and documentation system for all logistics process data.





The distinguished Council of Ministers approves allocating April 30 of each year as a day for the logistics sector. DAAD TRIP TO GERMANY

INVESTMENTS IN MADAYN SURPASS RO 7.4 BILLION



The total investment volume in all industrial cities under the Public Establishment for Industrial Estates "Madayn" has exceeded RO 7.4 billion, as stated by Eng. Dawood bin Salim Al Hadabi, CEO of Madayn. Al Hadabi noted that Madayn's sustained growth and expansion in various key metrics are attributed to the significant attention given by His Majesty Sultan Haitham bin Tarik to realize an optimal investment environment for both local and foreign investors, aligning with the goals outlined in Oman Vision 2040.

In terms of enhancing investor services,

Hadabi emphasized Madayn's commitment to streamlining procedures acrossits industrial cities. The Masar Service Centres, aimed at enhancing services and ties with partners, witnessed over 60,000 visits in 2023, delivering more than 55,000 diverse services with an average 3 minutes. processing time of Additionally, a new interactive system for receiving and responding nguiries is being developed enhance efficiency and

PORT OF SALALAH UNVEILS THE 1ST **BATCH OF THE WORLD'S LARGEST** SHIP-TO-SHORE CONTAINER **HANDLING CRANES**

On January 24th, 2024, the Chinese transport ship ZHEN HUA 25 delivered four fully assembled Megamax container cranes to the Port of Salalah, marking a historic moment. On January 24th, 2024, the Chinese transport ship ZHEN HUA 25 delivered four fully assembled



a historic moment. These colossal cranes, the first batch of a total of 10 cranes, have a lift height of 58.00 meters and an outreach of 75.00 meters. They are among the largest container gantry cranes globally and set new standards of size and capability. Salalah's container terminal is undergoing an upgrade to accommodate the largest container ships. The container terminal at the Port of Salalah already boasts a quay length of 2,197 meters, a draft of 18.00 meters, and an existing design capacity of 5.00 Mteu. The new cranes, part of the Terminal upgrade project which upon completion in O1 2025 will not only enhance its capacity to 6M TEUs but also bolster its capability to meet the evolving demands of the maritime industry. Keld M Christensen, CEO of Port of Salalah, welcomed these megamax container cranes to Salalah Port and said, "In welcoming these engineering marvels to Salalah Port, we mark a significant milestone in our journey towards enhancing global trade connectivity. These cranes not only elevate our port's infrastructure but also reinforce our commitment to delivering excellence in maritime services. With our partners and stakeholders, we continue to lead the way in facilitating efficient and sustainable trade operations, positioning Salalah Port as a premier gateway for international commerce". The arrival of these cutting-edge cranes marks a significant stride towards elevating Salalah Port's status as a global maritime hub. As the mega max-ready terminal continues to attract major players in the industry, it cements its position as a key player in handling the world's largest container vessels.In 1998, the Port of Salalah was established as a joint venture between APM Terminals and ASYAD, representing the Government of Oman. 


